BRUSH PICKUP POLICY:

- There will only be 1 Spring Brush pick up and 1 late Fall Brush pick up
- The dates will be posted on the Village of Fairgrove.org web page (Expect it to be Early May / Late November subject to weather and equipment failure)
- Storm brush pick up or any additional Brush pick up, will only be determined by the Village of Fairgrove Council & DPW worker and can be found on Village of Fairgrove.org web page

*Brush is defined as any limb of a tree that is larger than ½ inch and less than 3 inches in diameter. Brush that is too small, too large, not organic and leaves- yard waste- twigs will remain on the property and will be the property owner or resident's responsibility to remove with no further action by the Village of Fairgrove.

*There is a Dump available for Village Residents and arrangements can be made to drop off additional Brush at the Dump by contacting the Village of Fairgrove by email: VillageofFairgrove@gmail.com You must have an appointment. Anyone not accompanied by a dump pass may be subject to illegal dumping fines as determined by the Village of Fairgrove.

- Once collection of Brush on your street has occurred there will not be a second collection on your street and will remain on the property and will be the property owner or resident's responsibility to remove with no further action by the Village of Fairgrove.
- Once the Village wide collection is complete Residents will need to reference the Village of Fairgrove Ordinances #38 & #100 for further Blight actions that can be taken.
